



COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. These terms and conditions together with any specific rules set out in the competition notice (as defined below) constitute the competition rules ("**Rules**") and apply to the competition on www.puresouth.co.uk ("**Competition**"), unless otherwise expressly stated.

By entering the competition, entrants agree to be bound by these rules.

2. The Competition is organised by Alliance Group NZ ("Alliance") in partnership with The Staff Canteen.

3. Additional rules specific to each Competition are displayed on www.puresouth.co.uk/temanachallenge and will be referred to at the notice ("**Competition Notice**") and are expressly incorporated into the Rules. In the event of any inconsistency between the Competition Notice and these terms and conditions, the Competition Notice shall prevail.

4. In the event of any dispute regarding the Rules, conduct, results and all other matters relating to a Competition, the decision of Alliance shall be final, and no correspondence or discussion shall be entered into between Alliance and Competition entrants.

Qualifying Entrants.

5. To qualify to enter the competition entrants must fit the below criteria. Entrants must:

- Be an Executive chef, Head chef, Sous chef or chef de partie;
- Be over 18 years old;
- Have a restaurant(s) / or work at a restaurant based within the Classic Fine Foods delivery areas; (CFF locations are linked within the entry form stage or can be sent to anyone who requests it)
- Have a valid passport with no travel restrictions to travel outside the United Kingdom;
- Have a valid visa to travel to New Zealand at the time of travel;
- Be available between 9am – 6pm on **Monday 14th September** for the final cooking competition in London if you make it through to the final round;
- If you have previously won the challenge then you will not be allowed to enter.

6. By entering the competition, entrants hereby warrant that all information submitted by them is true, current and complete. Alliance has the right to verify the eligibility of all entrants.

7. Alliance reserves the right to disqualify any entrant at any time if it has reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached any of the Rules.

8. In the event that any entrant is disqualified from the Competition, Alliance at its sole discretion may decide whether a replacement should be selected. In the event of an entrant being disqualified any further entrant will be selected on the same criteria as the original entrant and will be subject to the Rules.

Competition mechanism.

9. Any qualifying entrant may enter the Competition. Entries for the Competition are limited to only one entry per company. Any entrant who enters more than the permitted maximum will be disqualified.

10. Entries for the Competition must be made between **Tuesday 3rd March 2020 – Friday 3rd July 2020**, using the dedicated page on www.puresouth.co.uk/temanachallenge. The entry drive may be extended due to popular demand.

12. Competition entries must be made in the manner and by the closing date specified in the Competition Notice and in these terms and conditions. Failure to do so will disqualify the entry.

13. All Competition entries are made free of charge. There is no purchase requirement to enter a Competition and there is no charge to register for use of the website.

14. Contestants will get to choose two cuts at the initial entry stage one cut must be chosen from both the primary and secondary cuts available. They will then use these cuts to create their dish and will be eligible to take part if they are within the **Classic Fine Foods** delivery areas. All contestants must use their primary and secondary cut to create **one dish** of which they will create with samples provided by Alliance if they make it through to the next stage.

15. Once the entry drive closes 25 contestants will then be chosen to go through to the next stage depending on their dish name, method, dish description & recipe being sent to them. The 25 contestants will then be contacted directly and will then receive their TE MANA lamb samples which will be delivered by Alliance or Classic Fine Foods on behalf of Alliance.

16. Alliance will expect all contestants to come back to Asia Walker, temana2020@alliancenz.co.uk with two pictures of their lamb dish by **Monday 3rd August 10am 2020**.

All pictures will be then uploaded on www.puresouth.co.uk/temanachallenge with the name of the chef, dish description and ingredients.

Process for determining the winner.

17. Between **Thursday 6th August 10am 2020** and **Monday 17th August 10am 2020**, all contestants' lamb dishes will be subjected to an online voting process generated via The Staff Canteen, the competing chefs and Alliance's social activities.

18. The **eight** dishes with the most votes from our online voting page will be invited to compete in the final cooking competition on **Monday 14th September 2020**. The finalists will then receive their chosen cuts of lamb again for the final cook off between **Monday 17th August 2020 & Friday 21st August 2020**.

19. Entries will be judged on their dish creation and other subjective criteria and the Competition judges (acting reasonably) reserve the right not to select a winner, and/or to remove or amend selection criteria and/or the structure and operation of the Competition if entries are not of the requisite standard.

20. The final Competition venue will be confirmed nearer to the final date and within a separate document.

Prizes.

21. The winner will win a trip to New Zealand organised by Alliance which will include the following:

- ✓ Return flights
- ✓ Accommodation & meals onsite for the duration of the stay (1 week)
- ✓ Transfer in-between locations in New Zealand
- ✓ A number of farms' visits to discover Alliance's premium range (compulsory)

Note that transport to and from UK airports; travel insurance and meals outside of the agenda of the trip are the winner's responsibility along with any additional costs incurred outside those identified clearly as part of the prize.

The winner will be given a fixed date within which to travel by the end of the 2021 calendar by Alliance. The trip will be part of the Pure South Discovery Series organised by Alliance in New Zealand and should occur in **April/May 2021/June** (TBC).

22. Prizes are non-transferable and there is no cash alternative. Alliance reserves the right to substitute prizes of equal or greater value at any time. Alliance reserves the right in its sole discretion to withhold delivery of the prize until such proof of eligibility and identity has been confirmed or if such proof is not produced on request or to disqualify the entrant from the Competition.

Intellectual Property Rights & Use of Entries.

23. Alliance does not, unless we agree this with you, claim any rights of ownership in your entry. As such, you retain ownership of your entry and, although Alliance will be able to use entries as set out in the Rules, you will also have the right to use your entry in any way you choose. Where any Entry is to be used in a different way (e.g. we are asking to own this) this will be made clear on the website and you will then be able to choose whether to enter the Competition. If you win a prize, as a condition to receipt of that prize, you may be required to sign a release form in connection with the prize-winning submission.

24. For the purposes of Alliance considering entrants to the Competition, each entrant hereby agrees that Alliance (and third parties authorised by Alliance) may make any and all entries available on the website and any other media, whether now known or invented in the future, which may include other internet sites, mobile, television and/or radio and that entries may be made available with advertising and/or sponsorship ("Purposes"). You hereby grant Alliance and The Staff Canteen (and third parties authorised by Alliance and The Staff Canteen) a non-exclusive, worldwide, irrevocable licence (for the full period of any rights in the entry) to use, display, publish, transmit, copy, make derivative works or podcasts from, edit, alter, store, reformat, sell and sublicense the entry for such Purposes.

25. Alliance does not guarantee to use or otherwise make available any entry. Alliance may also, in appropriate circumstances, and at its sole discretion, reject, edit, remove or disable access to entries that appear to be legally or otherwise problematic e.g. infringe the copyright or other intellectual property or privacy rights of others, are defamatory etc. or for any other reason.

26. Your entry and any information submitted by you must be personal to and relate specifically to you. You hereby warrant that you are the copyright owner of any copyright works submitted e.g. photographs of your dishes, and Alliance or The Staff Canteen's use of such works (which you permit), will not infringe the intellectual property, privacy or other rights of any third-party, and will not contain anything which is libellous, defamatory, obscene, indecent, harassing or threatening. If relevant, Alliance reserves the right, but not the obligation, to screen, filter and/or monitor information provided by you and to edit, refuse to distribute or remove the same.

Marketing.

27. All information submitted within the submission form may be used by Alliance for present and future marketing activities.

28. All recipes provided may be reused by Alliance either online, in printed material with credit going back to the original creator of the recipe.

29. All dish photos provided can be used online or offline by Alliance and the Staff Canteen during and after the competition.

Liability.

30. Alliance cannot accept any responsibility for any damage, loss, injury or disappointment suffered by any entrant entering the Competition or as a result of accepting any prize. Alliance is not responsible for any problems or technical malfunction of any telephone network or lines, computer online systems, servers, or providers, computer equipment or software, failure of any email or entry to be received on account of technical problems or traffic congestion on the Internet, telephone lines or at any web site, or any combination of these, including any injury or damage to entrant's or any other person's computer or mobile telephone related to or resulting from participation or downloading any materials in the competition. Nothing shall exclude Alliance liability for death or personal injury as a result of its negligence.

Where Alliance has disqualified an entrant, Alliance will have no further liability to such entrant.

Data Protection and Publicity.

31. The winner and the runners up may be requested to take part in promotional activity. By taking part in the Competition, you consent to your name, photographs, audio and/or visual recordings of you, and any comments made by you relating to the prize and Competition experience being used by Alliance and The Staff Canteen for promotional, marketing and publicity purposes in any media worldwide without any fee being paid to you.

32. Any personal data relating to entrants will be used solely in accordance with current UK data protection legislation and will not be disclosed to a third party without the individual's prior consent.

Data relating to entrants will be retained by Alliance and The Staff Canteen for a reasonable period after the Competition closes to assist Alliance and The Staff Canteen to operate future competitions in a consistent manner and to deal with any queries on the Competition.

33. Alliance (or any third party nominated by Alliance) may exercise its sole discretion to use the winner's name, restaurant name and address, image and their comments relating to the prize and

competition experience for future promotional, marketing and publicity purposes in any media worldwide without notice or without any fee being paid.

34. The winner agrees to engage with Alliance, its PR company and external media to promote the competition upon winning and after the tour has taken place without any fee being paid.

35. Information, and personal data which is provided by entrants when they enter the competition will be held and used by Alliance and their suppliers and contractors in order to administer the competition.

36. By submitting their personal details, the entrant agrees to Alliance processing those details in accordance with the purposes made known the entrant at the time of entering.

37. Alliance shall comply with all applicable requirements of the Data Protection Act 2018, the General Data Protection Regulation, any successor legislation or other applicable law.

Jurisdiction.

38. The Competition and Rules will be governed by English law and any disputes arising out of or in connection with the Competition and Rules will be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England.
